presented and each one achieved a Top Flight® award. Those cars were Jim Staub's 1957 fuel injected convertible, Pokie Wildhaber's 1964 coupe, Randy Rapp's 1967 coupe and Rex Gooch's 1979 coupe. Congratulations to each of you for achieving a nationally recognized standard of excellence. I thank my wife, Connie, for arranging the food for the luncheon.



As glad as I was to have such a nice group of cars to judge, I was equally pleased to have the participation and cooperation of so many members to judge and tabulate.



With only a few model years represented, I know that everyone was not able to judge vehicles with which they are most familiar. I do make an effort to make judging assignments as relevant for each individual as possible. That is one reason it is important to pre-register even if you are not having a car judged. The registration form lets me know who is coming and what their judging preference and level of expertise is.

I must say that I believe the level of judging within our chapter is making significant improvements. I attribute this to several factors. As our chapter has grown, we have had a larger selection of cars that have been presented for judging. This has also resulted in more and larger chapter judging meets. Where only a few years ago the chapter was

holding a single annual judging event with as few as two cars, more recently semi-annual events with as many as six cars have stretched our judging capacity. Another significant factor has been the willingness of many chapter members to participate in judging classes. This includes both



the national judging retreats and our locally sponsored judging schools. It was also of benefit to have sponsored a regional convention this year which permitted local chapter members exposure to the judging process at the next higher level without the necessity of long distance travel.

That said; room for improvement exists. I did notice several breaches of judging etiquette. I would remind everyone that these cars represent an owner's extensive effort and investment and should be afforded corresponding respect. Wearing belt buckles while judging as well as leaning against or

placement of clipboards upon vehicles must be avoided.

## Board Meeting Minutes

July 16, 2006 Meeting

With our Chapter and KC hosting the National Convention here in 2008 we may want to consider soliciting Chapter Banners as well. Bernie Meyer is scheduling the spring and fall Chapter Judging Events (reserving Love Park) and will advise Dave Beuscher of the dates. John Foster indicated he will schedule a Board Meeting towards the end of January.

Just a reminder to everyone that 2007 dues are due. We now have 70 members on our Chapter roster. It has been a long time since our Chapter was this large and this growth proves we can attract new members.
